SESSION TYPE	DESCRIPTION	FACULTY/TIMING
Case-based	Case presenters share brief clinical cases illustrating important teaching points relevant to learner/attendee. Use of the audience response system is highly encouraged to allow audience participation. <i>Slides are required; audience polling is highly recommended.</i>	2 Chairs 3 - 4 Case Presenters Audience Q&A 60-minute Sessions
Core Sessions	These heavily slide-based sessions allow speakers to share core knowledge, outcome-based recommendations, best practices and lessons learned from key experiences. Speakers will have 10-12 minutes to present followed by 3 minutes of audience Q&A. <i>Slides are required.</i>	2 Chairs 3 - 5 Invited Speakers Audience Q&A 60 or 90-minute Sessions
Debate	Spirited debate over controversial topics. One speaker will take the "pro" position while the other speaker takes the "con." They each have 20-minutes to present their case followed by a 5 minute rebuttal. Events & Networking	Plenary, lounge hours, & other sessions that do not fall within the traditional learning formats.	Custom program per session
Hands On Learning	Sessions intended for Fellows-in-Training to participate in engaging, tactile training on industries' latest technology and therapies. <i>Slides are not available.</i>	Custom program per session 2 Chairs Faculty serving as content experts

SESSION TYPE	DESCRIPTION	FACULTY/TIMING
How-To/Tutorial	How-to or tutorial-based sessions on performing high-level clinical procedures. These sessions should serve as training with key steps for the assigned topic. Speakers will have 10-12 minutes to present followed by 3 minutes of audience Q&A. <i>Slides are required.</i>	2 Chairs 3 - 4 Invited Speakers Audience Q&A 60-minute Sessions
Hyde Park	Freestanding sessions where 1 - 2 appointed speakers introduce new or controversial ideas or techniques. These non-ACE sessions take place outside of the traditional session rooms.	1 - 2 Speakers No Audience Q&A 20 - minute Sessions
Late Breaking Clinical Trials and Science	Didactic presentations of late breaking clinical trials and science submissions. Following each presentation, an assigned commentator will have 3 minutes to commentate on the science, followed by 2 minutes of audience Q&A. <i>Slides are required for LBCT presenters; slides are optional for commentators.</i>	2 Chairs 4 LBCT Presenters 4 Commentators Audience Q&A 60-minute Sessions
Moderated Poster	Rapid-fire presentation of significant clinical and translational research findings by category. Each presenter will present their abstract, followed by moderator-guided discussion. <i>Slides are required for abstract presenters.</i> These sessions do not include direct audience Q&A but space will be available to continue any discussion of presented abstracts nearby.	3 Moderators 6 Abstract Presenters 90-minute Sessions

SESSION TYPE	DESCRIPTION	FACULTY/TIMING
Oral Abstract	Didactic presentations of abstracts representing significant clinical and translational research findings by topic category. Top-scoring abstracts will be selected as oral abstract presentations. Each session consists of 4 abstract submissions with presentations lasting 12 minutes followed by 3 minutes of Q&A. <i>Slides are required.</i>	2 Chairs 4 Abstract Presenters Audience Q&A 50-minute Sessions
Panel Discussion	Speakers share their expertise and engage in back-and-forth discussion. This session type is designed to allow for new perspectives from a diverse group of panelists. These thought-provoking sessions will help foster collaborations and provide alternative approaches to both clinical and non-clinical topics. <i>Slides are optional; Chairs should come prepared with key questions to engage the panelists.</i>	2 Chairs 3 - 5 Panelists Audience Q&A 60-minute Sessions
Poster	Abstract presenters are assigned a 2-hour window of poster presentation time. The recommendation is to put poster up at the beginning of assigned session and stand by poster during the middle hour of the assigned session. <i>Slides are not available; presenters are required to bring a printed poster for display.</i>	0 Chairs Up to 232 Presenters per session 120-minute Sessions
Roundtable	Session rooms hold dozens of round tables offering attendees the chance to get up close and personal with the Roundtable Experts on a variety of topics. Sessions and speakers will be reached on a first-come, first-served basis with up to 9 seats per table. <i>Slides are not available.
