



## DEI ABSTRACT AWARD GUIDELINES

### IMPORTANT DEADLINES

All interested DEI Abstract Award applicants must submit their abstracts and indicate their interest before the Heart Rhythm 2023 abstract submission site closes on **December 5, 2022 11:59 PM Eastern Time**.

### ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

All authors must submit an abstract through the 2023 [abstract submission site](#), indicate their interest on the “Awards” section of the site. Abstracts submitted after 11:59PM Eastern Time December 5, 2022 will not be accepted. Please note that any abstract accepted into the YIA competition will not be eligible for this award.

### ELIGIBILITY

This award is open to abstracts that involve:

- Research with a mission narrowing the gaps in EP Healthcare (Basic Science, Translational Research, Clinical Research, Community Initiatives, Partnership with Industry)
- Research performed at granular level with a focus on HRS-defined underrepresented race/ethnic groups (UREG) patients.
- Research with a focus on inequalities in application of available therapies in clinical electrophysiology.
- Research that highlights solutions on plugged or leaky pathway for a women and/or UREGs.

### PROCESS

The Heart Rhythm Society’s DEI Committee, in conjunction with the Heart Rhythm 2023 Program Chair and Vice Chair will select the award winner. Award selection will be based on both relative abstract scores and relative subject matter.

### NOTIFICATION

The winner will be notified via email in March 2023.

### AWARDS

The winner will receive a Heart Rhythm Society DEI plaque, a cash award of \$1,500, honorary mention at Heart Rhythm 2023, and one complimentary registration to Heart Rhythm 2023.
